

# UPCOMING DISTANCE LEARNING CLASSES

## NETWORK+

STARTS NOVEMBER 1, 2016 · TUES & THURS · 8:00 PM

This course is designed for participants who are preparing for the CompTIA Network+ certification exam. The course provides foundation level skills needed to install, operate, manage, maintain, and troubleshoot networks. Prerequisite: Completion of IT Fundamentals, A+ Essentials or a background in IT.

## PROJECT+ (PROJECT MANAGEMENT)

This course features project management concepts required for planning and implementing both small and large projects. The course focuses on the various phases of the project life cycle from initiation to planning, execution, monitoring and closing out a project. Scoping a project as well as determining cost and time factors will be covered as well as processes for developing project plans, evaluating project performance, managing change, and assessing quality. Prepares participants for the current CompTIA Project+ certification exam.

## A+ ESSENTIALS
